



Big Themes

GLAMOR

Old Hollywood, 1920s and luxurious vintage themes are popular for 2016 (think lots of glitz, glam and sparkle).

HIGH ROLLERS

Couples are spending more in 2016—especially on extras such as engagement photos or entertainment like photo booths and music.

BOLD COLORS

Popular colors this year include bursts of reds and bright blues, along with pops of yellow as an accent, and gray neutrals to hold it all together. Metallic accents stay popular this year, emphasizing the glam factor.

SUBTLE **PERSONALIZATION**

2016 is less about big monograms and more about the subtle infusion of personality, such as using photos from a photo booth in a guest book, connecting food with couples' heritage or sharing personal










anecdotes throughout the venue.

Engagement Photography

Couples are spending more money than ever to capture the joy of their engagement. More than half of recently engaged couples plan to spend over \$250, and couples most often opt to have their photos taken outdoors. The beach is a popular location. Couples have even requested that their photos be taken at theme parks such as the Wizarding World of Harry Potter or Disneyland.



What wedding trends are you seeing right now? Individuality is the biggest trend I'm seeing. People aren't going with tradition. Weddings are no longer following traditional itineraries, and the ceremonies are generally much shorter than in the past.

Indicate the precise number of hours you will need a photographer and when, so he or she can give you a correct quote. One last tip: Look at their reviews as well as their images.



Wedding Planning

Prides are looking for more help from wedding planners this year than last year. They most often hire wedding planners to help with the overall wedding design (color scheme and layout), vendor selection and vendor coordination. Venue selection and RSVP management are also becoming more frequently requested. Great Gatsby-themed weddings will be popular this year, as well as the Country Chic and Rustic Outdoor looks that have been popular now for a few years. Poetryand Batman-themed weddings were among the most unusual requests.


Day-of Goordination

Prides in 2016 are hiring wedding coordinators to help with the main events: the ceremony and reception. Slightly more than half would like a coordinator to help with a cocktail hour, and 25 percent of brides would like the coordinator to help with the rehearsal dinner. Day of coordinators help guests know where to go and when, ensure vendors are set-up on-time and in the right spot, and generally ensure everything runs smoothly.

Hair Styling

popular last year are popular again this year, with updo's and half-up/half-down looks being the most popular (not surprising, given that 70 percent of brides plan to have long hair at their wedding). One big change for 2016 is the increase in popularity of hair accessories—everything from tiaras to flowers and accent clips are more popular this year compared with last year. In addition, more and more brides are requesting hair styling services not just for themselves but also for their bridal party, flower girls and family members.



Makeup

Traditional wedding makeup styles are still most popular this year. However, there has been a recent resurgence in the glamorous and bold look—in fact, there's been a 75% increase in brides requesting glamorous and bold looks for 2016 versus last year. This trend is underscored by the similarly large increase in brides requesting fake lashes and airbrushing.


so well that she actually ended up inviting me to her wedding!

What wedding trends are you seeing right now?
Brides are getting

bold! Literally. Many brides are getting dramatic with their wedding-day makeup styles. While the natural romantic look will always be a classic, ladies are definitely trying something new.

Instagram has really influenced this movement, I think. I ask all of my brides to bring photo examples of how they see themselves on their wedding day. Nine times out of 10, the photo is from Instagram.

What tips can you offer couples for finding a great makeup artist on Thumbtack? Consider how much experience the professional has and whether he or she is the right fit for you. Someone who has worked with a range of faces and skin tones will be better able to accommodate you and your makeup requests.

hen it comes to making the memories last, candid and traditional shots remain the most popular for today's couples. Artistic and environmental shots are also increasing in popularity. Budgets for wedding photographers have remained fairly constant, with 40 percent of couples expecting to spend \$1,000 or more for a wedding photographer.

Jennifer Baquing likes to think of photography as a way to change the world, one person at a time. With over 100 weddings shot since 2008, she loves the opportunity to help

people feel confident and beautiful and enjoys capturing them on their special day.

What's your most memorable Thumbtack wedding? The wedding of Christina and Brandon in South Lake Tahoe last September. Brandon's maternal family is Chinese, and when his grandmother was young, she went to South Lake Tahoe every year for church camp. As fate would have it, Brandon's grandmother met her husband at one of these church camps. Two decades later, Brandon's mother married his father at the exact same place, and Brandon and Christina wanted to carry out this family tradition. The weather was perfect, the food was delicious and the pictures turned out magical. I will cherish their day for the rest of my life.

What wedding trends are you seeing right now? I've shot more elopements and intimate weddings (less than 10 guests) in 2015 than in the past eight years combined. Smaller weddings

often allow more creative time for fun shots of the wedding party. As far as color schemes, apparel and décor go—l'm seeing a lot of coral, succulents and vintage-inspired lace dresses. Also, the instrumental version of "A Thousand Years" by Christina Perri—l've heard it used as the bridal entrance at least 20 times this year.

What tips can you offer couples for finding a great wedding photographer on Thumbtack?

Ask a lot of questions! Request a phone call, Skype session or in-person meeting. Chemistry is a huge part of creating successful wedding photographs. Yes, photography is a technical skill, but I promise that those breathtaking photos you see on Pinterest, Google, Instagram, etc., all have that intangible element that makes wedding photography so special






Videography



Highlight videos rather than full-length features will also be popular in 2016. To capture all the moments throughout the special day, couples often hire videographers for the entire wedding-from walking down the aisle to escaping in the getaway car.



A veteran videographer, Gary Magill first earned his chops shooting skateboarding videos at age 15. Since then, he's grown his love of filmmaking into a successful videography business. He takes pride in constantly honing his craft

and films everything including music videos, short films, advertisements, quinceañeras and-most important-weddings.

What's one of your most memorable wedding experiences? One of my most memorable and meaningful weddings was when I captured a close friend's special day. I told the groom that if the bride didn't cry after watching the video of wedding highlights I had created that meant I had done a bad job. Sure enough, he called me when they watched it and said, "Gary, you got my girl crying here!"

What wedding trends are you seeing right **now?** One cool trend is when videographers and DJs work together to create a more meaningful experience for everyone at the wedding. For example, the videographer can interview family and friends before the ceremony and ask them to share special stories about the couple-how they met,

personal experiences with them, their love for each other, etc. The videographer passes this recording along to the DJ, and while the music is playing during the reception, dinner or dancing, the DJ can mix in the audio from the interviews so those stories of love get broadcast over the whole party.

What tips can you offer couples for finding a great wedding videographer on Thumbtack? Choose someone who matches your aesthetic and can tell the story of your special day in an authentic way. Look at several photographers' work before hiring to learn about their style. Check out each photographer's sample videos and social media accounts.



Officiant

wedding officiant plays one of the most important roles on the Big Day. This is the person who will set the tone for your ceremony and legitimize your union; it's not a decision to be made lightly. In 2016, an increasing proportion of couples are requesting nondenominational and nonreligious weddings. For these ceremonies, requests for candle and sand ceremonies are especially popular. Also popular in 2016 are vow renewals for 10th and 20th anniversaries.







The groom's mother was viewing the ceremony from Siberia and, although she didn't speak English, her beaming smile was priceless.

What wedding trends are you seeing right now? I see a lot of couples who want intimate backyard ceremonies. They invest money in home improvements and select wedding vendors rather than full-

service wedding venues.

What tips can you offer couples for finding a great wedding officiant on Thumbtack? Read the reviews! Learn about other couples' experiences with the officiants' services. When you think you've found the right person to officiate your ceremony, make sure you're sufficiently able to communicate your wishes and needs.

Florist

flowers set the stage for an event, and this year, sunflowers are making a comeback. Traditional wedding flowers such as roses, lilies and peonies are still in the Top 5, though. Baby's breath is also very popular as a light, airy and inexpensive alternative to expensive hydrangeas, which have also been popular in the past few years. Brides in 2016 will use flowers more frequently than they did in 2015 to decorate their ceremony and reception venue. Incorporating floral arrangements into aisle decorations and cake table décor is also becoming more popular.

What's your most memorable Thumbtack wedding? The Huntley Wedding at the McCoy Equestrian Center in Chino Hills because of the amazing group effort it entailed. The Huntleys originally hired me through Thumbtack as their wedding florist, but it evolved into a bigger collaboration. The bride-to-be was overwhelmed by wedding planning while raising her one-year-old son and working full-time, so I offered my event management services. She especially needed day-of help setting up all her decorations.

When I say all her decorations, I mean an 18 foot U-Haul filled with decorations handmade by her and her fiance. They really put in the extra time and effort to ensure that their venue was decorated beautifully, and I ensured that everything was up and ran smoothly the day of the wedding.


right now? Every bride and client is different! But if I had to pick the most popular one, it would have to be the rustic look. Lots of baby's

What are your tips for finding a great wedding florist? If I receive a floral inquiry but the bride doesn't include flower choice, flower colors or services needed on her wedding day, I do not take the time to even respond. There's no way to send a price if I don't know what services the bride wants.

Sometimes I even get inquiries that don't have a date for the wedding. The more details and specifics you provide, the more accurate the price will be, and the more likely you'll be happy with the outcome.










Music & Entertainment

The energizing sounds of pop and Top 40 are most likely to get wedding guests out of their seats in 2016. Couples are requesting a mix of genres to keep everyone happy, recognizing that several generations will be in attendance. Most couples also want their DJ to play the MC role to make announcements, introductions and lead group dances. Couples often request songs that remind them of their heritage or relationship.



sure they have the right genre for your event. When looking for a DJ, don't always look for the cheapest price. The DJ can make or break the party, and you want to have a great party.



Gatering

Gouples in 2016 will more often opt for fancy sit-down dinners, complete with serving staff and bartenders. Requests for servers are up 25 percent and requests for bartenders are up 42 percent. Given a turn toward more formal dinners, couples are also upping the ante on the cuisine—opting for Italian and formal American fare, rather than casual cuisine. Couples are increasingly looking to connect the cuisine offered at their wedding with their own heritage and family traditions, with many couples requesting that caterers recreate special family recipes.

that met their needs. Ramon was in the
restaurant industry and wanted the food to
be really special on his wedding day. We
helped them host a giant cocktail reception
and everyone had a blast.

What wedding trends are you seeing right now? We're seeing a lot of couples request a full cocktail reception with hors d'oeuvres. Passed apps all night means the party never stops. It's also an opportunity for couples to showcase foods that let their personalities shine through.

What tips can you offer couples for finding a great wedding caterer on

Thumbtack? Answer as many of the caterer's questions as possible! It's hard for vendors to take care of clients without knowing specifics about budgets, needs and—especially—the wedding date.

There is no such thing as too much information. Also, be honest about your price range. Low price ranges are not really doable for full-service weddings—especially when you need a bar, staff and table rentals. Be open and honest, and

the right vendors for the job will respond.





ost couples hire a limo to get (2) **VI** from point to point—often from the ceremony to the reception and sometimes with stops on the way to take photos with their photographer. Over 70 percent of couples request a limo for fewer than four hours. Most couples also hire buses to transport guests to and from the ceremony, reception and hotels. Couples often hire buses for a longer amount of time than limos, with over 60 percent hiring a bus for more than four hours.


